When submitting your project for the competition a 4-5 minute video is required where you demonstrate your project.

The video must meet the following requirements:

- The name(s) of each participant
- The name of the app
- Clearly explain the purpose of the app (Students should do this in **one clear sentence**)
- The tools and coding languages used to create the app
- Explain how the app works

We strongly recommend that you do a screen recording of your computer along with a recording of your voice and your teammates voices if you have teammates.

To screen record on Mac, you can use the following link for instructions on how to use Quicktime player, which should already be on your computer as it is made by Apple.

- 1. Go to https://obsproject.com/ and download OBS Studio for windows.
- 2. Under the Scene tab press the + icon to add a scene.
- 3. Under the sources tab press the + icon to add a source.
- 4. Press Display Capture and press OK.
- 5. Start Recording and you are set to go!
